



How to Make Terra-Cotta Pot Place Cards

(as seen in May/June 2013 *Cooking With Paula Deen*, page 60)

Materials:

Small terra-cotta pots
Multisurface acrylic craft paint, white
Plastic wrap, as needed
Fresh floral foam
Single-stem roses
Place cards (template follows)
Glue or glue dots
Craft paper
Wooden sticks

Directions:

- Paint terra-cotta pots by brushing paint on pot and smearing with paper towel to get an aged whitewash look. Let dry.
- Line pots with plastic wrap if they have a drainage hole. Place a small piece of fresh floral foam in base of pot, and saturate floral foam with water.
- Place a single rose in foam, and fill in pot with fresh moss.
- Print blank place cards, write guest's name on them. Fold a small piece of craft paper in half, and glue place card on it. Place a wooden stick at the base between the fold, and glue the stick to craft paper. Glue interior sides of craft paper together to enclose stick.
- Insert stick with place card into moss.
